She co-founded and is the president of Washington's Paramount Duty, a grassroots group of over 7,000 parents and allies working to compel Washington state to fully and equitably fund Washington's public schools and ensure every child gets an excellent education. In the past year, she met with over 60 legislators and testified at over 10 public hearings.

She has also served in leadership roles in many organizations, including at Oregon State University, University of Oregon, New York Cares, San Francisco Street Project, and the PTA. Her most treasured accomplishment is being a mom to a sixth grader, who attends Robert Eagle Staff Middle School.
