



Cascadia is on a mission to eliminate the idea of waste by partnering with Terracycle!

Did you know that you can bring in some kinds of non-recyclable or difficult-to-recycle waste to our special Terracycle collection station at Cascadia? The collected waste is converted into new products, ranging from recycled park benches to upcycled backpacks. Terracycle pays for shipping costs, and Cascadia earns points and receives funds for each piece of waste we collect and send in.

To help, bring in the following to the blue Terracycling Center in the lobby across from the Main Office. While some programs have specific brand sponsors, in general all brands can be Terracycled.

Toms of Maine Natural Care Recycling Program:

Mouthwash bottles and caps, deodorant containers and caps, toothpaste tubes and caps, soap packaging, floss containers, and toothbrushes

Energy Bar Wrapper Recycling Program-LÄRABAR®:

Any foil-lined energy bar wrapper

GoGo squeezeZ® Recycling Program

Healthy snack plastic pouches and caps

Crayola® ColorCycle Program:

Plastic markers, including dry erase markers and highlighters

Cartridge World®:

There are also buckets next to the blue bin for a printer cartridge Recycle Rewards Program at a local Cartridge World storefront. Small cartridges from home-style printers are the most valuable; we earn market value for intact, reusable ones and keep them out of the waste stream.
