Artist Trading Cards by Elaine Woodhouse	\$156	K-5	Thursday, 3:30 - 4:30 PM	<p>Artist Trading Cards (A.T.C's) are miniature works of art measuring 2.5" x 3.5". They are created using a variety of materials, and a multitude of art techniques. They became an art form in the late 1990's introduced by Swedish artist M. Vänçi Stirnemann. They appeal to all ages, and are collected and traded throughout the world. I have been teaching the art of A.T.C's since 1999 to both children and adults. Student ages have ranged from 5 – 85 years of age (sometimes in the same group!) Artist Trading Cards are meant to be collected, shared and traded. In this time of socially distancing it is a perfect art form for helping children and adults maintain contact with family and friends!</p> <p>Students will receive a collector's binder/protector sheets/ blank cards mailed to them before the start of the session. They will also receive weekly "FEATURED CARD OF THE WEEK SURPRISE ENVELOPES!" Each class starts with a short "How-to" video related to the "featured card" Students can decide to create the featured card and/or design their own with the materials provided. The remainder of the class will be working and sharing with other students.</p> <p>In keeping with my teaching philosophy, the virtual classes are relaxed and supportive of the social and emotional needs of each student. ### **Fall 2020 Pilot Session Policies**

#### **CLUB OFFERINGS:**

Kids Co. is working to create a well-rounded virtual club offering for families and kids. **Virtual Extended Learning opportunities (VELO)** is a Kids Co. pilot program that will be tested this fall term for an **abbreviated ELO session of 5 to 6 classes**. Due to the change from in-person ELO to virtual extended learning opportunities (VELO), Kids Co. will not be creating individual sessions based on your child's school. Instead, we will create a single session where families have the opportunities to register for a specific club – this will create an opportunity for students to engage virtually with students all over the City of Seattle!

#### **VIRTUAL ACCESS:**

Club vendors and instructors will provide the virtual learning platform for your child to access the class. Families are responsible for ensure that they have a device that supports the program and have adequate internet access for their child to engage in class. For the Fall Pilot Session, Families will have 9 days to register their child for VELO programs. This registration is done through ACTIVE, Kids Co.'s preferred online registration platform. Links for registration will be sent via PTA organizations and to all Kids Co. mailing lists. Registration will be on a first come, first serve basis. In the event that a club reaches capacity, Kids Co. will encourage the vendor to add an additional class or increase their enrollment. Please keep in mind due to various financial, scheduling, and quality reasons – this may not always be possible. **If families have an outstanding balance they will not be able to register for classes until that balance is paid in full.** Please click registration link and log into your account to pay any balances due.

#### **CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS:**

In order for Kids Co. to be able to cover the cost of the registration website, marketing, administrative hours, and various other aspects of running VELO programming, we charge a \$20 non-refundable registration fee at the time of registration.

In the event that the vendor needs to cancel the course due to low enrollment, Kids Co. will refund families the tuition for the club minus non-refundable registration fee. Kids Co. is working hard to develop a course offering that has low enrollment goals in order to ensure as few cancellations as possible.

In the event that your family chooses to cancel the class registration, Kids Co. will refund all but the \$20 non-refundable registration fee as long as families request the cancellation prior to the end of the registration period. If a family requests a refund after the registration period has ended, Kids Co. will not be able to process a refund. This is non-negotiable.

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## **TRANSFER:**

If a family would like to transfer courses during the registration period, Kids Co. can complete the transaction prior to the end of the registration closure. Families will be responsible for paying any differences in tuition between the two clubs and must complete the payment prior to the start of the first class. Transfers between clubs are not permitted once the registration period has ended.

## **LATE REGISTRATION:**

The ability for families to register after the registration period has closed will vary from class to class based on the vendor's policy. Ability to register are not guaranteed and Kids Co. will not be able to waive any non-refundable registration fees. Kids Co. will not be able to prorate tuition and/or fees for late registration.

## **SCHOLARSHIPS:**

Due to COVID-19 and the financial impacts it has had on businesses, scholarships will vary by vendor. Most of the vendors Kids Co. uses for club programming are local small business. Many of these small businesses, including Kids Co. have experienced a significant loss of income due to school closures and stay at home orders. We will do our best to provide scholarships from vendors when possible, but cannot guarantee scholarships will be available.
