

## **Cascadia Info Sheet 2025**

### CASCADIA ELEMENTARY AND THE HIGHLY CAPABLE COHORT (HCC) PROGRAM

- Cascadia will be welcoming new students entering for the 2025/26 school year into the Highly Capable Cohort (HCC) program.
- Students who enter into an HCC cohort <u>will be able</u> to finish in the HCC program at Cascadia (i.e., they will be able to graduate from Grade 5 at Cascadia under the HCC program).
- Students can join the HCC program at any grade level offered at Cascadia.\*
- Cascadia offers Math 2 years above grade level.
- Cascadia offers English Language Arts 1 year above grade level. The ELA curriculum also offers enrichment in many forms such as Mensa poetry, Caesar's English and cursive writing instruction.
- Graduating from an SPS HCC school (e.g., Cascadia or Decatur) is the <u>only</u>
  way to be learning Math 2 years above grade level in middle/high school.
  - The district no longer allows kids to accelerate in middle school by testing in.
  - The district is allowing kids who attend their neighborhood school to advance 1 year in middle school ONLY. There is no more testing-in based on ability.

<sup>\*</sup>Currently Cascadia offers grades 2-5; we are waiting for a definitive plan from the district on the grades that will be offered next year but we believe it may be 3-5. Even as a 3-5 school, Cascadia will be quite large - over 400 students.

### SCHOOL PROGRAMS, SUPPORT, AND A STRONG SENSE OF COMMUNITY

- Cascadia offers music, PE, choir, art, a gardening program, an iLab program (a tinkering/STEM program), newspaper club, weekly library class, technology skills education in a computer lab, and selected affinity groups.
- Cascadia provides a math Interventionist to ensure all students are supported in the math acceleration.
- Cascadia hosts events throughout the school year such as Spelling Bee, Science and Engineering Night, Culture Night, and participates in the Global Reading Challenge.
- Cascadia organizes meetups to welcome incoming and returning students over the summer break.
- Cascadia offers a robust after-school enrichment program, including coding, Orlov's Chess, and more.
- Busing is available for students. Route assignments are issued late August.

You do not need to sign up for RSVP for these evening events. For Jan 30th, the event will start at 6pm with a presentation and Q&A in the gym (approx 40 min), after which you will be able to independently tour the building - there will be a staffed classroom in each grade level wing and all of the specialist classrooms will be open for viewing (ilab, art and music rooms). There will be PTA volunteers present if you have any questions. For Feb 25th, the event will start at 6pm with a presentation and Q&A in the gym (approx 40 min), and then there will be current student/parent-led tours through the building, including the ilab, art and music rooms and grade level classrooms.



### **HOW TO APPLY TO CASCADIA**

The district has posted a timeline on the <u>Identification and Eligibility page</u> under Advanced Learning. This includes when new HC identifications will be sent to parents and how to opt into Cascadia and Decatur for next year\*\*\*.

Universal Screening/new eligibility decisions are made by the Multi-January 21-31, 2025 disciplinary Placement Committee (MPC). February 1-14, 2025 **Universal Screening continues** Eligibility Letters are sent to families February 19-22, 2025 and posted in The Source. February 19- March 7, Families can submit an appeal for 2025 1st-8th grade students only. The MPC will review each appeal and provide a written decision to the parent/guardian within 25 March 12-14, 2025 school days of the receipt of the appeal form and all documentation/proof.
